## How to Make an Appointment After the First Visit

\*\*COVID-19 test is not available at our clinic. If your child has a fever (37.5 °C or 99.5 °F and up), please seek your local healthcare organization.

Please visit our online appointment portal: https://www.yoyakuru.net/rs/kujikodomo/web/KI001.aspx

Use Patient ID (issued on your first visit) and the eight digits of the child's birthday as password in YYYYMMDD format (i.e. If your child's birthday is on October 5<sup>th</sup> 2019, enter "20191005"). You may also use QR code printed on the Patient ID.

If more than one of your children need to visit, we kindly ask you to make appointments for each of your children. Their visit time will be the earliest appointment time you have, even if they may have different appointment times.

All available slots will be highlighted in blue. Closed slots will be grayed out. If you are not able to make an appointment, we will accept walk-ins until 12pm. Your child will be attended after children with appointments, but please make sure to visit before noon. There will be no walk-ins in the afternoon.

Our appointment system works simply to keep track of the order of your turn instead of reserving an exact time. Once you successfully make an appointment, you will be able to see how many children are being attended ahead of your child. We suggest that you log back in consistently to keep track of your turn, and please see our receptionists when it is your turn. Please note that your appointment will be cancelled if you are late.

## Three Types of Same-Day Appointments:

- 1. **AM**: Appointment portal will open at 6am. Our clinic opens at 9am. You will not be able to make an appointment for the PM at this time.
- 2. **PM**: Appointment portal will open at 12pm. Afternoon appointments will begin at 3:30pm.
- 3. **Newborn Care**: Available on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, either at 3pm or at 3:10pm, and by appointment only. To make an appointment, please visit our appointment portal and select 'Newborn Care' which is highlighted in green. This appointment portal is open 24 hours and also allows you to make appointments for the next two months (three visits total).
  - This portal is strictly available for attending newborns up to 12mo.
  - Please show up at least 5 minutes before your appointment time.
  - Please bring your baby's health record card provided by your hometown, otherwise you will be asked to pay out of pocket.
  - Your hometown is responsible for the check-ups for 5mo, 18mo, and 36mo.

## About Immunizations:

Please make appointments through our appointment portal.

- Immunizations are not available on Sundays.
- Don't forget to bring health record book, insurance card, and all other important documents.

RV (Rotavirus vaccine): Available only in AM. The first dose should be administrated before 14 weeks and 6 days of age. You may select one of two licensed vaccines (Rotarix® or RotaTeq®). Both vaccines are given by putting drops in the child's mouth.
